

**RESOLUTION ON PUBLICATION OF AFRICAN  
YEAR BOOK OF INTERNATIONAL LAW**

The Council of Ministers of the Organization of African Unity meeting in its 25<sup>th</sup> Ordinary Session in Kampala, Uganda, from 18 to 25 July 1975,

**Considering** the importance of publishing an African Year Book of International Law,

**Concerned** that the subject of the publication has lingered since the 13<sup>th</sup> Ordinary Session of the Council,

1. **DIRECTS** the Secretariat to reinforce its efforts of obtaining the views of Member States on outstanding matters – finance, location of publication etc. – relating to the publication of the Year Book;
2. **URGES** Member States to communicate their views to the General Secretariat as urgently as possible;
3. **DIRECTS** the Secretariat to synthesize available views of Member States on the subject, and to put up concrete proposals on the subject for consideration of the council at its next Session;
4. **TAKES NOTE** of the candidature of Algeria to host the headquarters of the African Year Book on International Law.
