RESOLUTION ON THE MIDDLE EAST AND OCCUPIED ARAB TERRITORIES

The Council of Ministers of the Organization of African Unity meeting in its Twenty-Seventh Ordinary Session at Port Louis, Mauritius, from 24 June to 3rd July, 1976.

<u>Having considered</u> the report of the Administrative Secretary General of the OAU on the Middle East problem (document CM/736);

Having heard the statement delivered during the session by the representatives of the Arab Republic of Egypt, the P.L.O. and other delegations;

Recalling the resolutions adopted by previous sessions of the Assembly of Heads of State and Government and the Council of Ministers and on the Palestinian problem and in particular AHG/Res 76 (XII) and CM/Res 459 (XXVI).

- ENDORSES the report of the Secretary General as contained in document CM/736 (XXVII);
- 2. **FURTHER ENDORSES** Resolution CM/459 (XXVI) by which the Council reaffirmed its total and effective support for Egypt, Arab front line States and the Palestinian People.
