RESOLUTION ON THE INTERNATIONAL SYMPOSIUM ON RACISM AND DANGERS IT REPRESENTS TO MANKIND

The Council of Ministers of the Organization of African Unity meeting in its Twenty-Seventh Ordinary Session at Port Louis, Mauritius, from 24 June to 3rd July, 1976.

<u>Having been informed</u> of the forthcoming international symposium in the Libyan capital from 24 to 29 July 1976 on racism and the dangers the latter represents to mankind;

Realizing the dangers racism in all its forms represents as a flagrant affront to human rights;

<u>Convinced</u> of the need to stand up against this phenomenon through unity of the freedom fighters;

- 1. **URGES** member-countries and African liberation movements recognized by the OAU to participate in this symposium;
- 2. **CALLS** upon the Administrative Secretary-General of the OAU to co-operate closely with the Arab Republic of Libya to ensure the success of the symposium;
- 3. **EXPRESSES** its appreciation to the Arab Republic of Libya for its initiative.
