## RESOLUTION ON THE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTIVITY OF PEASANT FARMERS IN AFRICA

The Council of Ministers of the Organization of African Unity meeting in its Twenty-Seventh Ordinary Session at Port Louis, Mauritius, from 24 June to 3<sup>rd</sup> July, 1976.

**Nothing** that the majority of the African people derive their livelihood from farming and other agricultural activities;

**<u>Pursuant</u>** to Resolution CM/Res. 381 (XIII) on raising the productivity of peasant farmers in Africa;

**Considering** the report, CM/771 (XXVII), on the expert's panel for raising the productivity of peasant farmers in Africa that was held at the OAU Headquarters from 3 to 7 May 1976;

- REQUESTS the Secretary-General of the OAU to forward the document of the experts as well as the recommendations to member States for their observations and comments.
- 2. **INVITES** further Member States to take all steps to ensure the success for future technical expert meetings dealing with this question, which will be held whenever necessary.
