RESOLUTION ON INTERNATIONAL LIQUIDITY CREATION

The Council of Ministers of the Organization of African Unity, meeting in its Thirteenth Ordinary Session in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, from 27 August to 6 September 1969,

<u>Having studied</u> the report of the General Secretariat of the OAU dealing with "International Liquidity Creation and its implications for African countries",

<u>Being aware</u> of the shortcomings of the existing international Monetary System with regard to the development needs of the African countries,

<u>Reaffirming</u> the recommendations contained in resolution CM/Res. 179 (XII) passed at the Twelfth Ordinary Session of the Council of Ministers,

RECOMMENDS that Member States:

- (1) INSTRUCT the African Governors of the IBRD and the IMF, within the context of the forthcoming Joint Annual Meeting of these two organizations and with a view to reaping maximum benefit from the new SDRS facility, to negotiate for:
 - the easing of conditions attached to IMF drawings at the higher credit installments;
 - o the increase of IMF quotas of OAU Member States;
 - a link between the SDRS facility and development finance through the periodic replenishment of IDA resources through the pledging of a uniform portion of the SDRS accruing the Part I countries of the IDA;

(2) REQUESTS the Administrative Secretary General to persist in his efforts to service the activities of the African Governors of the IMF and the IBDR, with a view to firmly establishing active African participation in the decision-making process of the IMF and the IBRD.
