## **ORDER**

- 1. The matter has been the subject of several prior orders directing Respondent to execute Judgment No. AUAT/2020/006. Applicant now comes with a motion asking for additional orders against Respondent because Respondent continues to defy the Tribunal's orders.
- 2. On 19 February 2021, the Tribunal entered an order of contempt against Respondent and his Counsel and entreated Respondent to take accountability measures against those responsible for the non-execution of Judgment No. AUAT/2020/006. In addition to ordering Respondent to execute the judgment within 15 days (**no later than 6 March 2021**), a 5% interest was imposed on all judgment sums as of 12 November 2020.
- 3. These orders were affirmed on 1 April 2021.
- 4. In the present request, Applicant has attached several troubling electronic exchanges between herself and the Office Legal Counsel, causing the Tribunal significant concern about Counsel for Respondent's respect for Tribunal orders.
- 5. The evidence that Respondent submitted is all the more shocking: minutes of a meeting where some officials of Respondent discussed suspending execution while Respondent investigated the administrative decision addressed in the judgment.
- 6. A judgment of the Tribunal is final, immediately operative, and without appeal; its execution does not require the approval of Respondent or his officials.<sup>1</sup>
- 7. In the circumstances, the Tribunal understands Applicant's "frustration, sense of injustice and anxiety" arising from Respondent's disregard of the Tribunal's authority.<sup>2</sup>
- 8. Accordingly, the 5% interest previously imposed is ESCALATED to 10% as of 6 March 2021 and is ORDERED to run until full payment.
