DECISION ON DEMOCRATIC TRANSITION IN TUNISIA

The Assembly,

- 1. **CONGRATULATES** Tunisia on the successful democratic transition crowned by the progress of the legislative and presidential elections in a conducive environment and **CONSIDERS** the successful of the Tunisian experience as possible model for democratization process in Africa.
