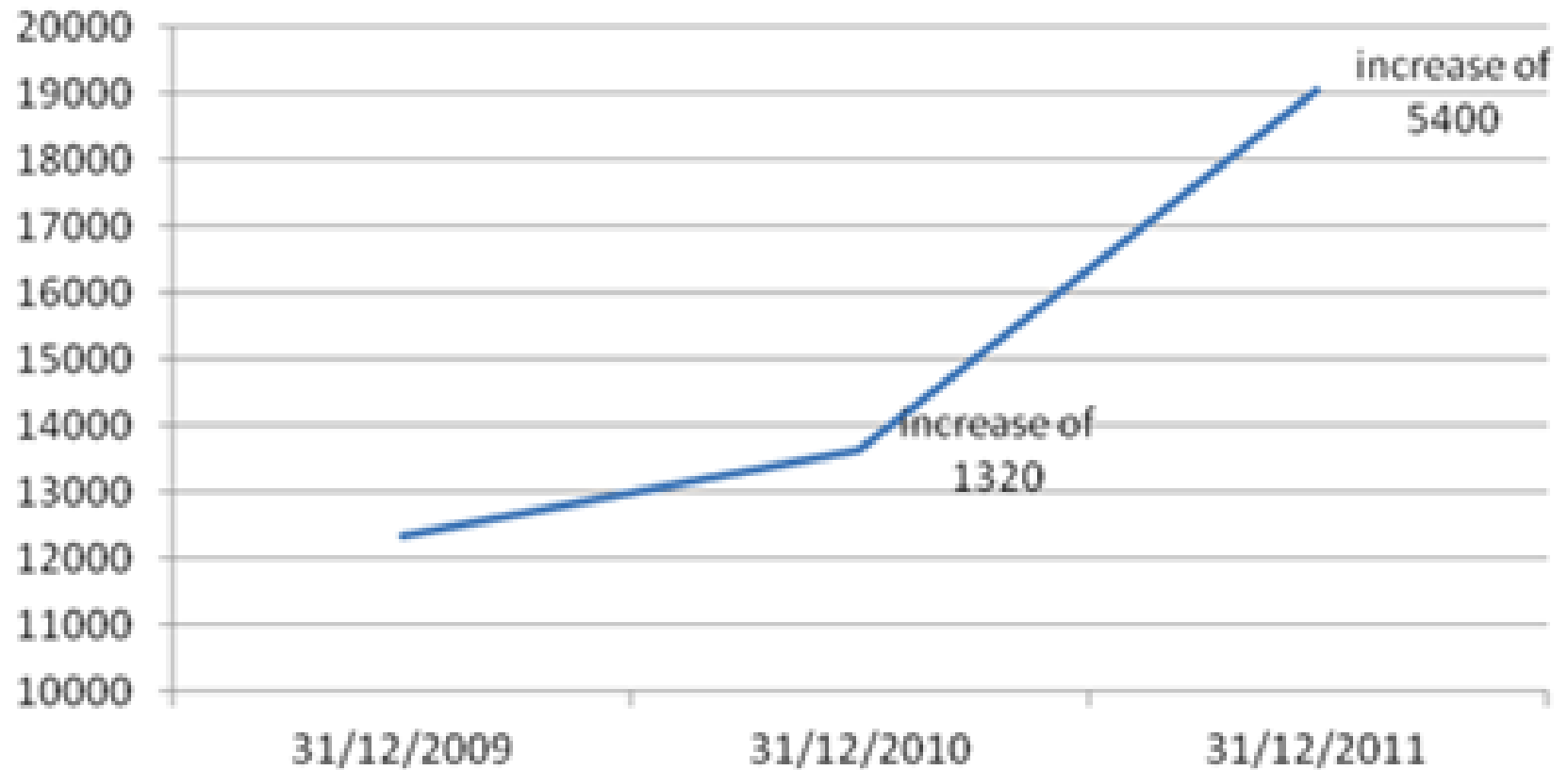
Constitutional Court Trust's Objectives

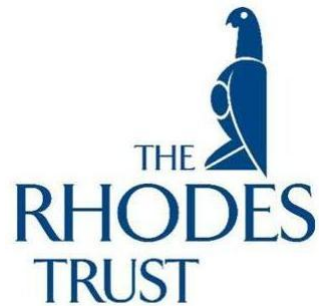
