NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that His Excellency the President acting in accordance with regulation 30G of the Emergency Powers (COVID-19) Regulations, 2020, has authorised that –

- (a) the following may operate between the hours of 0800 hours and 2200 hours –
 - (i) agricultural shop,
 - (ii) bakery,
 - (iii) butchery,
 - (iv) funeral parlour,
 - (v) general dealer,
 - (vi) pharmacy or chemist, or
 - (vii) supermarket, and
- (b) the following may operate between the hours of 0600 hours and 2200 hours –
 - (i) a restaurant, and
 - (ii) a take away, and
- (c) fuel filling station may operate for 24 hours.
