Under section 22(2) of the Public and Environmental Health Act, 2015 (Act [No. 1 of 2015](#)), I declare the severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2) known as COVID-19 to be a formidable epidemic disease for purposes of that Act.
