I, Fikile Mbalula, MP, Minister of Transport, acting in terms of regulation 10(7)(a) the Regulations issued in terms of the Disaster Management Act, 2002 ([Act No. 57 of 2002](#)) hereby issue the directions extending the validity period of operating licences and accreditation certificates as set out hereunder:

- a) The validity period for all public transport operating licences and accreditation certificates for tourist transport services that are due to expire during the lock-down, shall be deemed to be valid and shall be extended for a further grace period of 90 days from the date of expiry of a lock-down period, unless determined otherwise by the Minister.
- b) The offices of the National Public Transport Regulator and Provincial Regulatory Entities will remain closed during lock-down period.

This Notice shall become effective from the date of publication in the *Government Gazette*.
